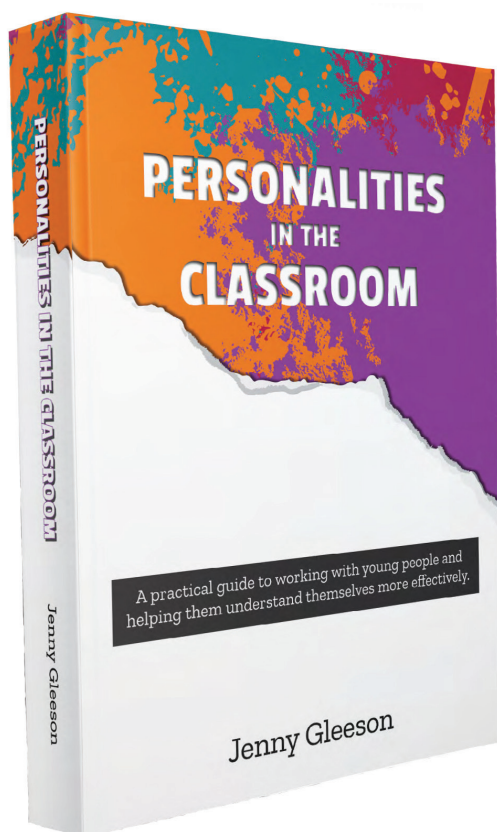


PERSONALITIES IN THE CLASSROOM
